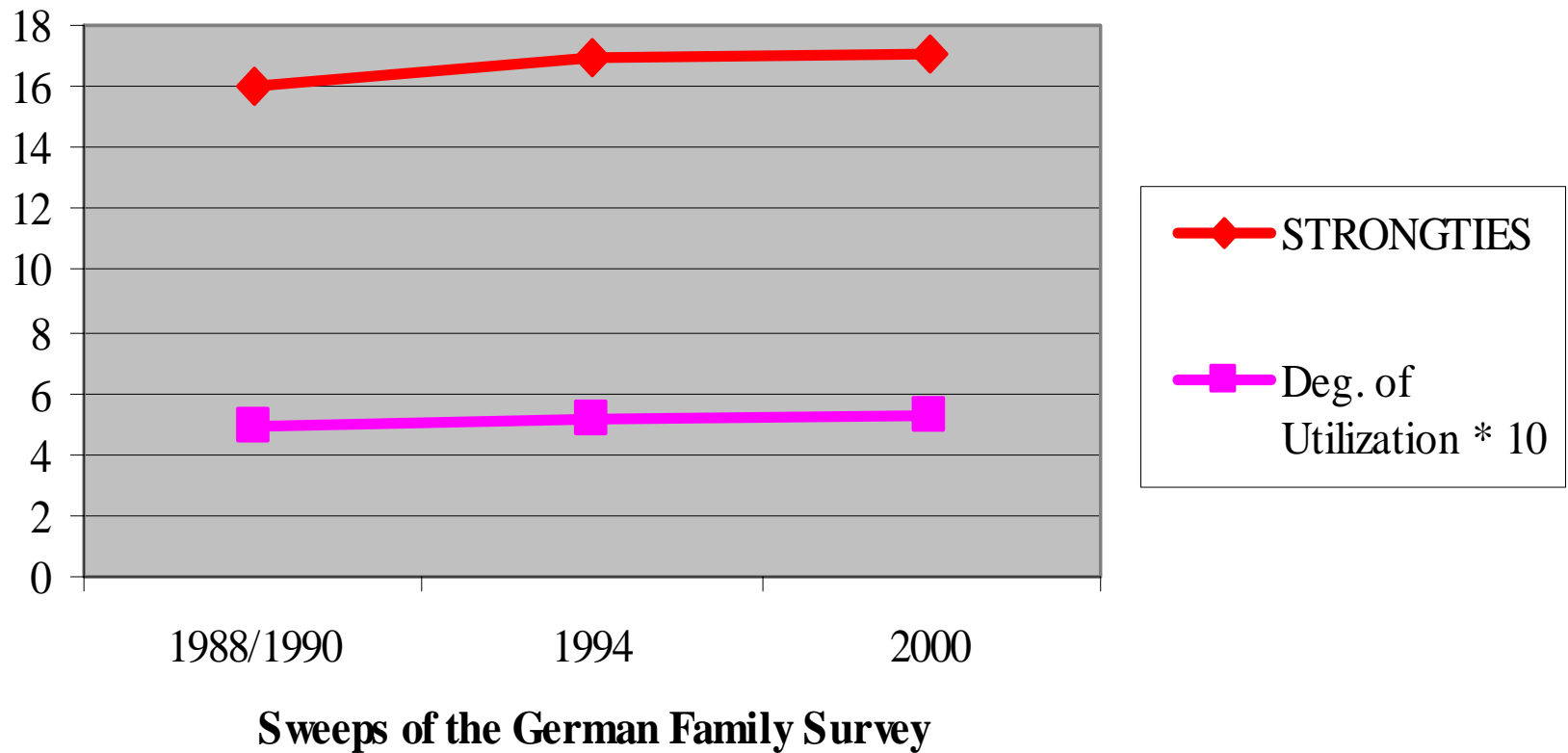

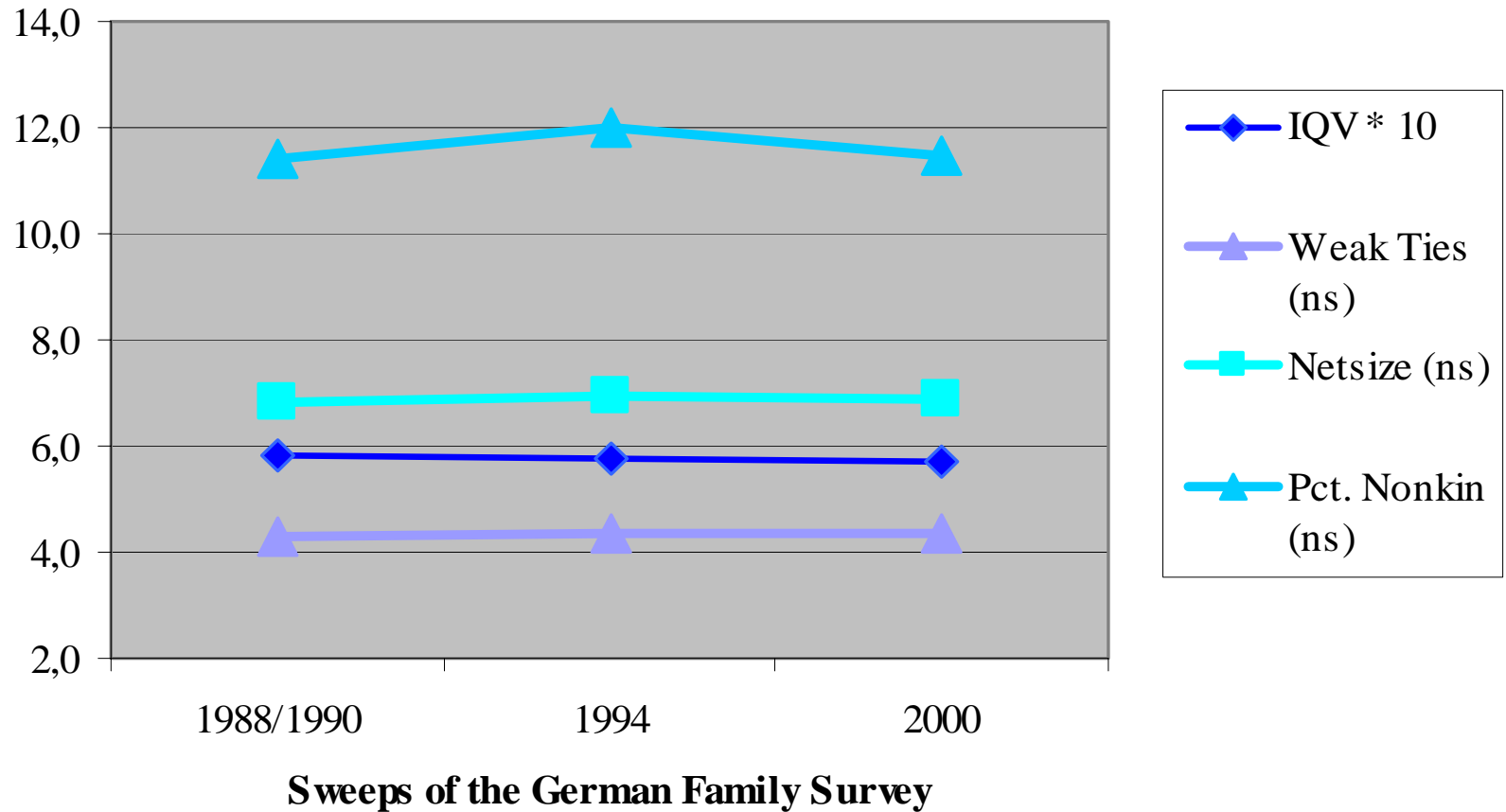

Coleman-Capital (STRONGTIES) and its Degree of Utilization (* 10) in Germany



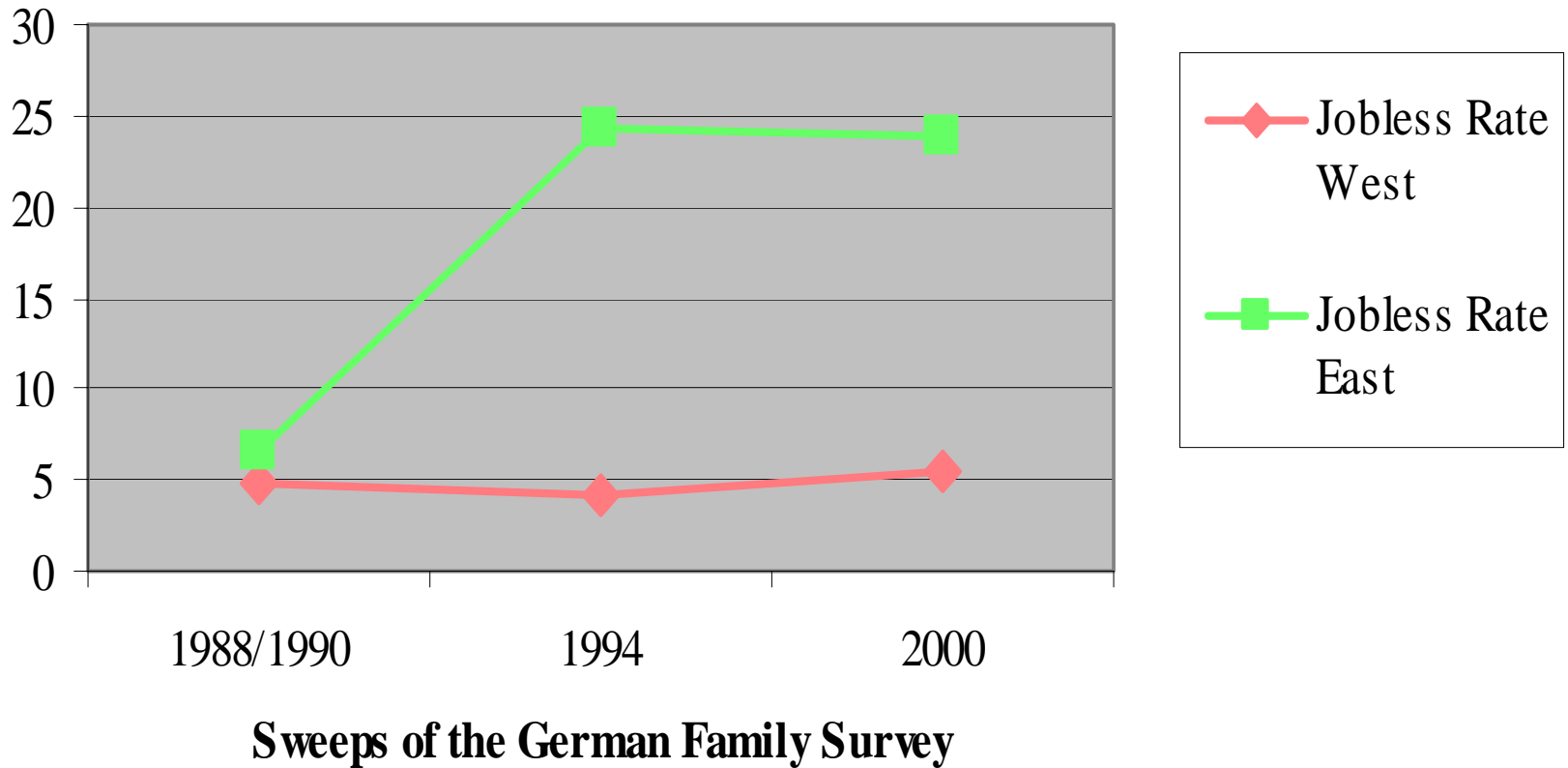

Granovetter-Indices in Germany: IQV (*10), WEAKTIES, NETSIZE, Pct Nonkin



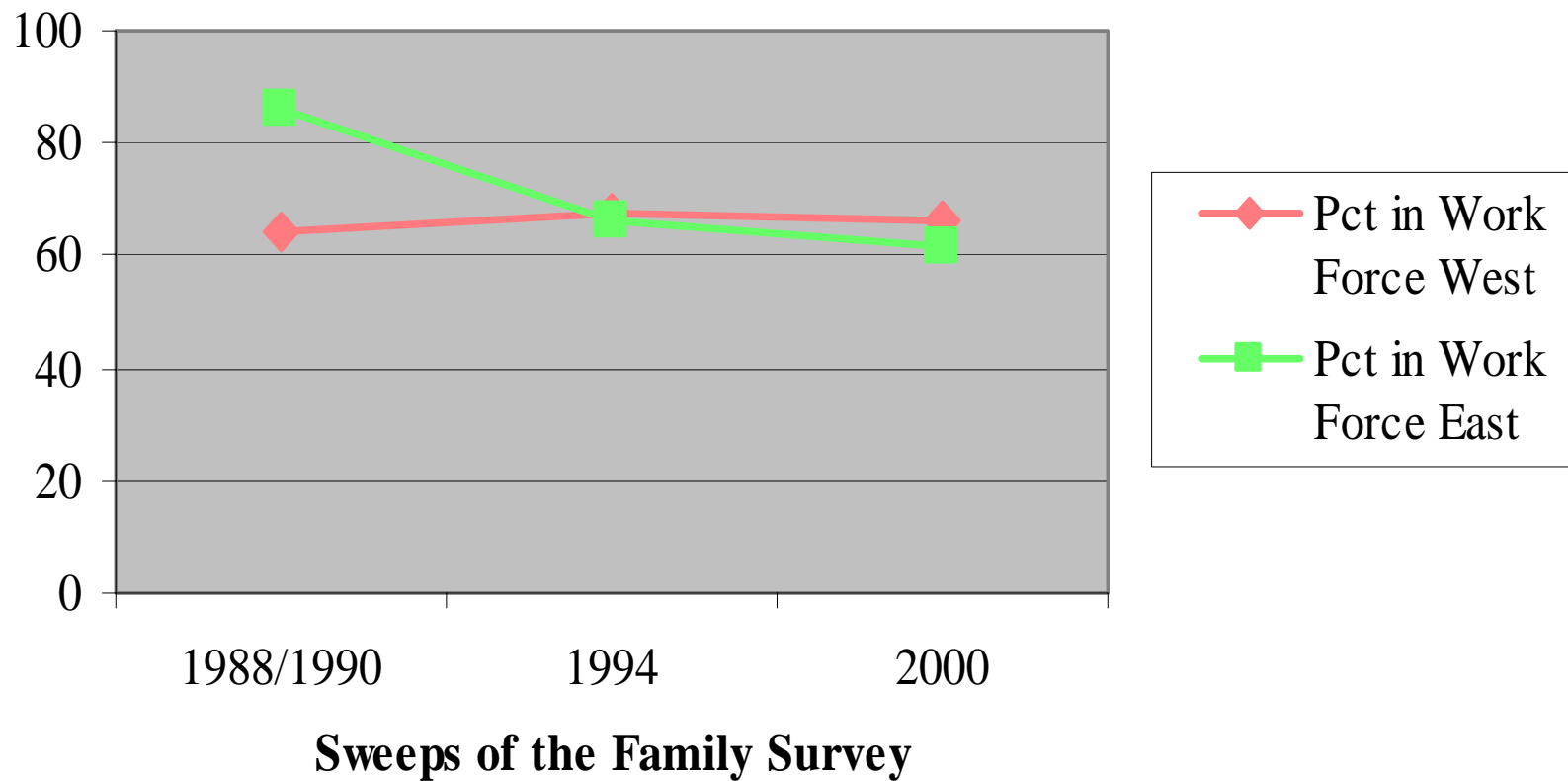

Jobless Rate (Pct.) of West and East German Respondents



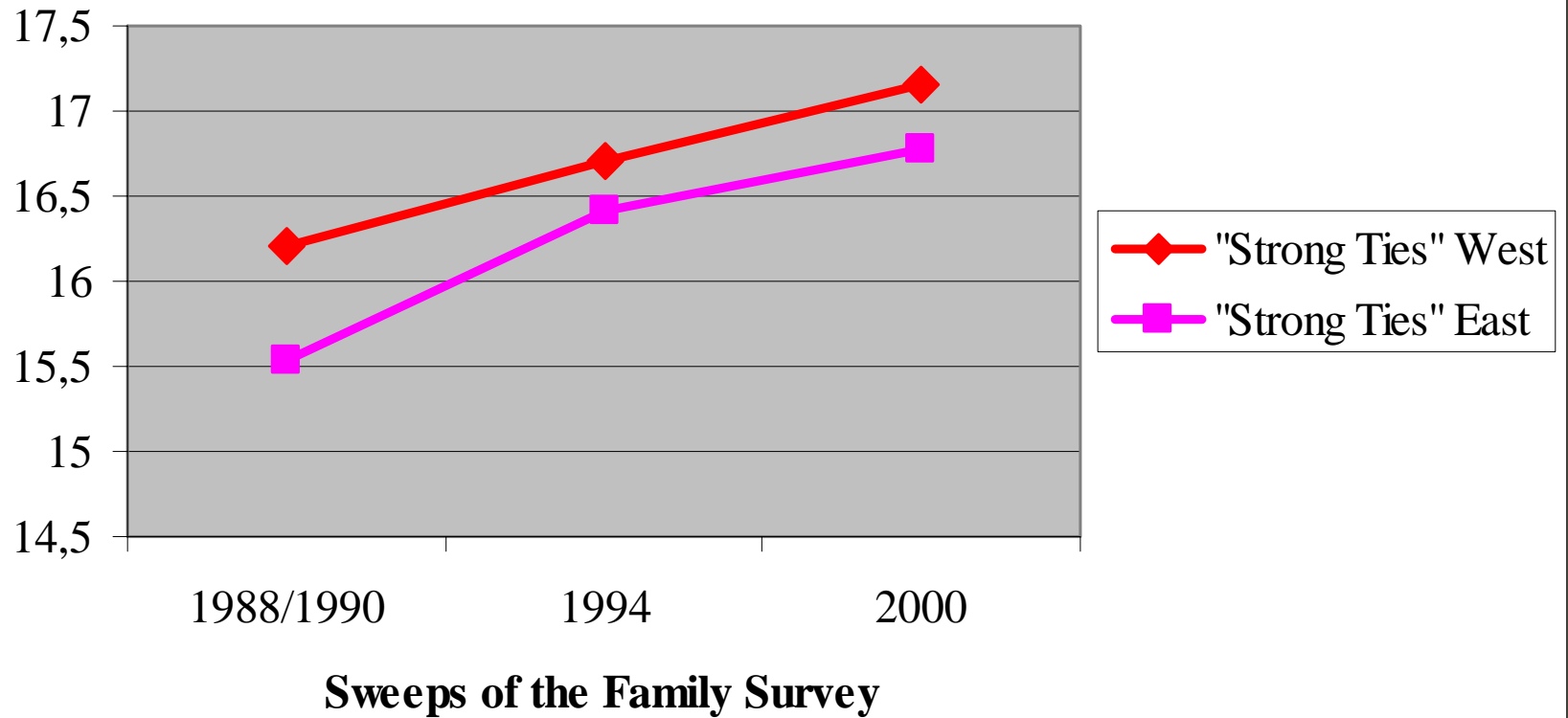

Pct. of West and East German Respondents in the Work Force



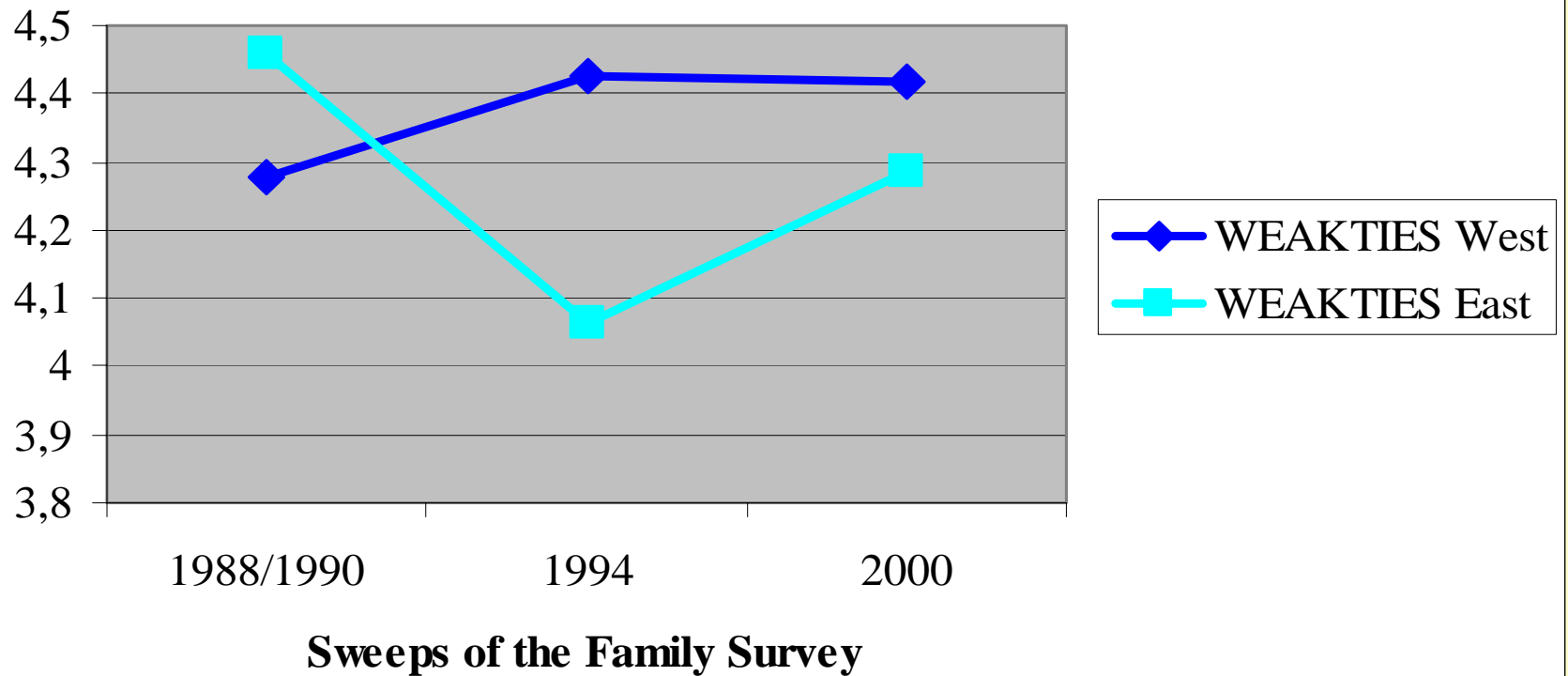
